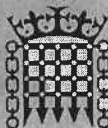

It is essential that Government support is secured for the future sea link between Penzance and the Isles of Scilly.

Local Councils and organisations who are rightly anxious about this following the Government's decision to merely extend the 'conditional approval' for the link project contacted me to seek a meeting. You were not amongst these.

Your opinion both of yourself and your group and that of Penzance Business Network are noted and (as you have sent him a copy) will, I am sure, have been noted by the Minister. I hope you will not mind if the Minister and I do not become drawn into an issue of local contention which you are clearly seeking to advance in this way. I am determined that any meeting with the Minister should be focussed on the primary objective set out above.

Although I will, of course, ask the Minister if he is prepared to meet you as well, even at this very late stage, I have to be honest and say that it is very unlikely. You may like to approach either of the two groups of organisations who will be represented in Parliament on 15th December.

If you would like me to forward your letter to those who originated the proposals for meeting the Minister and to ask if any of the delegation is prepared to give up a place in your favour then I would be happy to do so.
