Cornwall Council's 'Option A' harbour scheme is out-of-date, expensive, wasteful, risky for council tax payers, and damaging to Penzance. There are less destructive alternatives that fit with the town's aspirations for regeneration around the harbour and that provide a modern, high quality solution to the needs of the ferry service.

Cornwall Council now has planning permission for its Option A scheme but it is the Department for Transport that will decide in the next few weeks exactly what investment is made in the Isles of Scilly Link Scheme and what changes are made in Penzance Harbour.
